

## 2025 Bib

Fabric: Flannel on front OR flannel on back but not on both sides.

Small leftover pieces can be joined and used on the front OR the back of the bib.

Be sure the front and back match as to gender.

Do not use lining in between layers.

Cutting: Use the pattern to cut one front. Cut the back 11 X 14 1/2 inches.

Lay the back right side up.

Lay the front onto the back, right side down. (Right sides together) Fig. 1

Leaving a small opening about 2-3 inches for turning right side out and following the front, sew the layers together, starting at the bottom and sewing all around. Use a 1/2-to-3/8-inch seam allowance.

Trim seam and clip curves so the bib lies flat when turned. Fig. 2

Turn right side out and slip stitch the opening. Press.

Top stitch about 1/2 inch from the edge, all around.

Put one size 16 snap on the tabs. Fig. 3.

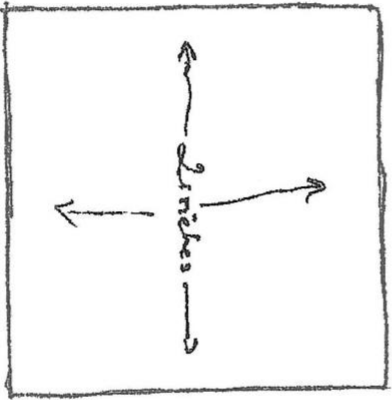

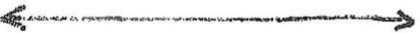
